"Our best interests as black Americans," Owens said, "lie in a new direction that reflects our core beliefs and values, not merely a resemblance of someone we look like."

Again, before the election, quoting her uncle, King said, "There comes a time when one must take a position that is neither safe, nor politic, nor popular, but one must take it because it is right." And, she added, "This is not the time to be silent; this is not the time to give Barack Obama a free pass. There is too much at stake."

But, the fact is, Barack Obama did get a pass right back into the White House, thanks, in part, to forty million Christians who turned their backs on Jesus and the Bible. They are complicit in the murders of unborn babies and the immorality of homosexuality and same-sex marriage. They will have to give an account for their votes.
